Overview

In 1891, Luther H. Gulick, M.D., proposed a triangle as the symbol of the YMCA. The equilateral triangle represents a holistic approach to personal development. Each side—mind, body and spirit—reflects the Y's dedication to nurturing, not just individual parts of our well-being, but a whole person approach to developing well-balanced individuals and strong communities. "We are not a mind and a body and a spirit, but the wonderful result of their union" (Luther H. Gulick, M.D., 1894).

The Triangle Society, named after this meaningful and enduring symbol, honors individuals who share a deep commitment to the YMCA's purpose and values. Your generosity enables individuals, kids, and families from diverse backgrounds to achieve lifelong success. It is through your philanthropic investment that we can provide programs and services, from cradle to career and beyond, that nurture the whole person and strengthen communities to build a better world.
