Enclosed you will find the following information: director information, staff information, camp theme, safety policies & procedures and daily schedule.


### DROP OFF AND PICK UP

Lagos Winter Break Holiday Camp will be primarily operating out of the school cafeteria. We ask that for drop off and pick up, you park in the side parking lot and approach the door under the awning as pictured below.

During morning drop off, please ring the doorbell to gain access to the school. For pick up, we ask that you ring our doorbell and wait for our team to answer. You will then be led to your child's group to sign them out after you have been verified as a pre-authorized adult to pick-up. Please remember to bring your I.D. daily when you pick up your child.
