# **WELCOME TO WINTER CAMP!**

#### DROP OFF AND PICK UP

Spicewood Winter Break Holiday Camp will be primarily operating out of the school cafeteria. We ask that for drop off/pick up you please turn into the parking lot off Tin Cup Dr. and park in the back lot, next to the playground. Approach the door under the awning as pictured below.

During morning drop off, please ring the doorbell to gain access to the school. For pick up, we ask that you ring our doorbell and wait for our team to answer. You will then be led to your child's group to sign them out after you have been verified as a pre-authorized adult to pick-up. Please remember to bring your I.D. daily when you pick up your child. #### **CAMP HOURS: 7:30 AM - 6:00 PM**

Staff cannot accept your child before 7:30 AM. Additionally, your child must be picked up and signed out by an authorized pickup person by 6:00 PM each day. Please note that late fees will occur for pick-ups that occur after 6:00 PM.
